



TERMS OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUTTS NUTTS (THE PROVIDER) AND THE CLIENT

1. The Provider will walk the Dog for the time specified and on the days as detailed on the consent form. The Provider reserves the right to walk other dogs at the same time, but the total number of dogs walked with one person at one time will not exceed [5].
2. The Provider will walk the Dog on other occasions by arrangement.
3. The Provider will provide this service either personally or by a person appointed by and working under the Provider's instructions.
4. The Client will either ensure that access is given to the Provider to collect the Dog from the agreed address at the agreed times or give the Provider a key to gain access. The Provider will use the key to collect and return the Dog and for no other purpose and will keep it safe, not let anyone else have it, not copy it and will return it to the Client on demand, keys will be securely stored and will have a coded identity.
5. The Client will supply suitable collars or harnesses for the Dog and any coats or other accessories which the Client wishes to be used. The Provider will be entitled to refuse to walk the Dog if a suitable collar or harness is not provided and to be paid in full as though that walk had taken place. The Provider will supply suitable lead for the dog.
6. The Provider's charges are at the rates agreed.
7. The Client will inform the Provider fully of any characteristics of the Dog which needs to be known for handling and care of the Dog.
8. The Provider holds insurance in respect of public liability, care custody control of animals and loss of keys. The client is strongly advised to have their own personal insurance cover.
9. The Provider will inform the Client of any incident or anything which the Provider notices about the Dog, which as dog owners the Client ought to know.
10. The Provider will keep the Dog/dogs on a lead unless prior arrangement has been made to walk the dog/dogs off lead whenever out of the house, will take care so far as is practicable both that the Dog is not a nuisance or danger to any one, or any other animals, and that no harm comes to it. Dogs will never be walked off lead near roads.
11. The Client will provide the Provider with details of the Dog's inoculations and contact details of its vet. In case of need the Provider is authorised to refer the Dog to the named (or in emergency any other) vet for advice or treatment at the Client's expense. The Client undertakes to reimburse to the Provider all expenses incurred under this clause.
12. The normal walking time will be 1 hour, this does not include travelling time, however the Provider may curtail the walk due to extremes of weather in the interest of animal safety.



13. The Provider agrees to look after the dog whilst in its care as though it was their own.
14. The Provider shall supply clean drinking water as required on walks and will towel off dogs as best as possible after their walk.
15. Pet Taxi rate will be charged at £10.00 + £0.40p per mile, the client is responsible for informing the vets/groomers the Provider is attending on their behalf, and to ensure that arrangements for payment have been made direct to the vets/groomers or to the Provider.
16. Either party may terminate this notice by not less than one week's notice to the other at the address given in this agreement.
17. Payment for the service provided to the client by the Provider is to be made in advance either by direct bank transfer, standing order, cash or cheque.
